b.2 Applications received by the PENRO/CENRO shall be forwarded to the Regional Office within three (3) working days from receipt of the applications;

- b.3 Within three (3) working days upon receipt of the application, the Regional Office, through its concerned Division/Unit, in collaboration with the Regional Wildlife Management Committee (RWMC), shall conduct evaluation of the documents, including inspection, assessment and validation of the ivory specimens applied for registration based on the inventory/list submitted. Within five (5) working days after completion of said inspection and assessment, the concerned RWMC and Regional Office's Division/Unit shall submit its inspection report, including recommendations to the Regional Director;
- b.4 Within three (3) working days upon receipt of the application, complete documents and recommendations, the Regional Director shall make a final review/evaluation of the application and documentary requirements. The Regional Director shall render a decision approving or rejecting the application after the three-day final evaluation. If approved, the RED shall issue the Certificate of Ivory Registration (CIR) within three (3) working days after the decision has been made. If disapproved, the applicant shall be notified of such denial within three (3) working days after rendering such decision;
- b.5 The CIR shall be released to the applicant after payment of the Registration Fee.

Section 7. Responsibilities of Holders of Certificate of Ivory Registration (CIR):

- 7.1 Strictly comply with the terms and conditions of the Certificate of Ivory Registration;
- 7.2 Keep a record of all transactions pertaining to the ivory included in the inventory submitted to the DENR Regional Office concerned;
- 7.3 Secure Local Transport Permit (LTP) for the domestic movement of raw and/or worked elephant ivory within the Philippines;
- 7.4 Secure CITES Permit for the export/import/re-export of raw and/or worked elephant ivory;
- 7.5 Submit annual report and inventory of the raw and/or worked ivory every end of the year to the concerned DENR Regional Office, copy furnished the Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB.)

138	Section 8. Separability Clause . Should any part or provision of this Order be
139	subsequently judicially declared invalid, illegal, unconstitutional or otherwise improper,
140	all other parts and provisions not affected shall remain valid and enforceable.

142	Section 9. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
143	publication in a newspaper of general circulation and upon acknowledgment of receipt of
144	a copy thereof by the Office of the National Administrative Register (ONAR).
